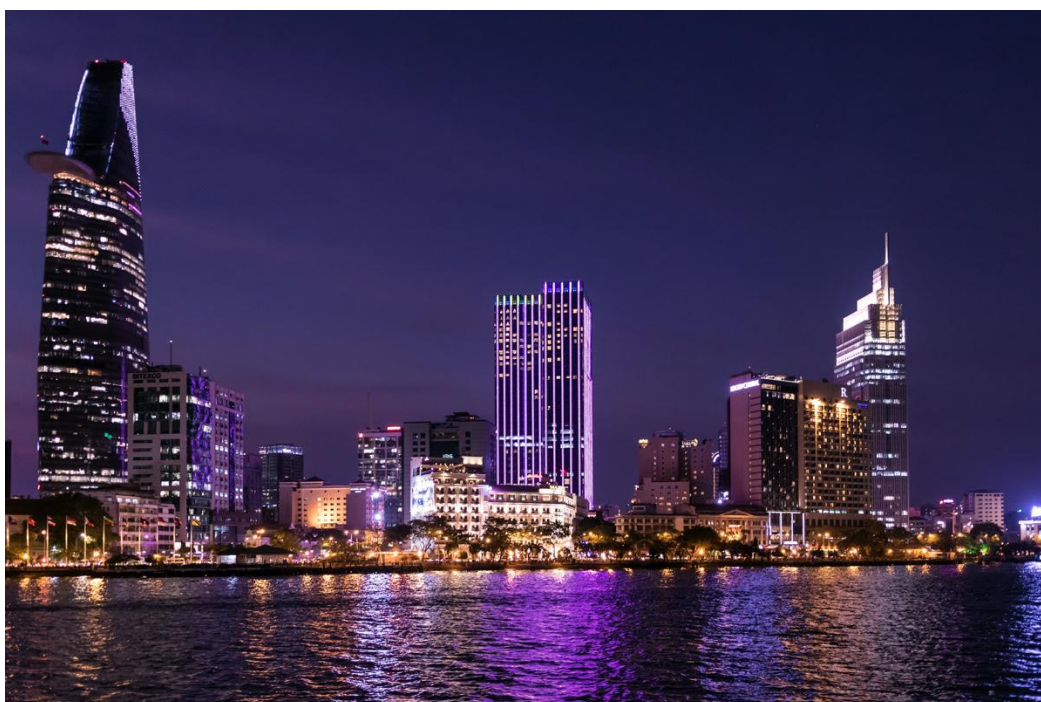

ASIIN, with support of the Vietnamese Ministry of Education and Training, is hosting this state-of-the-art conference, which will address a range of “hot topics”, that are currently high on the Vietnamese and international QA agendas.

What In the opening session, we together will explore the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in all aspects of higher education. European and Vietnamese Experts will discuss the opportunities and challenges posed by AI sharing global best practices, addressing the incorporation of AI into Teaching and learning, research and HE administration.

Session 2 will present best practice examples from both Vietnam and Germany on how to institutionalize modern management systems in higher education and how to implement successful features of institutional autonomy.

Session 3 will be devoted to the topic of internationalization and present successful examples of international collaboration in higher education and regarding the provision of skilled workers for the countries’ economies. We will jointly highlight the possibilities for higher education exchange between

Germany and Vietnam, also probing into issues such as **how to initiate Joint International Study Programs** and presenting strategies on how to modernize study programs in their quest for meeting international standards. Successful institutions will share their best practices, the German Academic Exchange Council will present the range of opportunities available to Vietnamese higher education institutions, and representatives of Foreign Trade associations will focus on the benefits of professional mobility.

Session 4 at the opening of day 2 **will address the topic of international rankings** and the reasons they are of relevance to the Vietnamese and German Higher Education Sector. Representatives of international Ranking Organizations will deliver insightful presentations on where Vietnam and Germany currently stand.

The conference, **in its final session**, will end with an exploration of the range of options for international quality assurance and ASIIN's unique capacity building and quality enhancement portfolio. Participants in the first session will learn about ASIIN's **innovative Global University Network of Excellence (AGUNE)** and the new **ASIIN Academy** as platform for a variety of courses and workshops serving the professional development of staff members of Universities and QA Agencies. We will present the potential of ASIIN's institutional "maturity model", program accreditations based on international quality seals as well as certification of continuous professional development courses. This final part sets the stage for a comprehensive understanding of quality assurance and international benchmarks.
